


Earn ABOS Maintenance of Certification Credits through Registry Participation


As part of its wide variety of data reuse initiatives, the American Academy of Orthopaedic Surgeons (AAOS) Registry Program provides surgeons the opportunity to earn up to 10 self-assessment examination (SAE) credits for the American Board of Orthopaedic Surgery (ABOS) Maintenance of Certification (MOC) Part II.

Steps to attain MOC Credit:

- 1. Be a contracted participant in an AAOS Registry
- 2. Active data submission
 - Your hospital, health system, or practice needs to be actively submitting data on your behalf (active = at least quarterly)
- 3. Login to the RegistryInsights® platform to view your data
 - You have access to download your MOC certification at any point via the Surgeon Dashboard on RegistryInsights



- 4. Have your certificate validated and credit awarded by AAOS Registries staff
 - After you have downloaded your certificate from RegistryInsights, you will email
 it to RegistryInfo@aaos.org and state what year you are seeking credit for
 - o You can obtain up to 10 SAE credits for each year of participation in the Registry
 - Separate certificates are needed for each year you are interested in receiving credit
 - An AAOS Registries team member will validate your participation in the registry, confirm active data submission, and award SAE credits



5. Submit your validated certificate to the ABOS portal for review
