Election Day: November 3

Why should you vote?

Voting is the one of the most powerful ways to make your voice heard in our democracy, but in 2016, only 61.4% of the voting age population in the United States reported voting.

Modern technology has improved access to information on candidates and made it easier to register to vote in many areas, and it is vital to be aware of how you can participate in the 2020 election.

Colorado's absentee and mail-in voting procedures

Permanent absentee / mail-in voting procedures:

- Every voter receives a mail-in ballot by default

2020 state absentee / mail-in voting status:

- No announced changes to voting procedures due to the coronavirus pandemic.



Deadlines to know for voting in Colorado

Voter registration deadline:

October 26, 2020

Eight days before an election.

Same-day registration is permitted during early voting and on Election Day;

Deadlines for voter registration drives are 22 days before an election

Absentee / Mail-In voting ballot deadlines:

Request must be received by

Application Not Required

Automatically sends ballots to all eligible voters

Ballot submission deadline:

Mail ballots must be received by 7:00 pm on November 3, 2020 (Election Day).
