Election Day: November 3

Why should you vote?

Voting is the one of the most powerful ways to make your voice heard in our democracy, but in 2016, only 61.4% of the voting age population in the United States reported voting.

Modern technology has improved access to information on candidates and made it easier to register to vote in many areas, and it is vital to be aware of how you can participate in the 2020 election.

New Jersey's absentee and mail-in voting procedures

Permanent absentee / mail-in voting procedures:

- No excuse required to request an absentee ballot

2020 state absentee / mail-in voting status:

- Coronavirus updates: Sending all registered voters an absentee ballot for the November 3, 2020 election.



Deadlines to know for voting in New Jersey

Voter registration deadline:

October 13, 2020

Twenty-one days before an election.

Absentee / Mail-In voting ballot deadlines:

Request must be received by

October 27, 2020

Seven days before the election

Ballot submission deadline:

In person: Must be received by close of polls on November 3rd, 2020 (Election Day).

By mail: Postmarked by Election Day and received by County Board of Elections within 48 hours of the polls closing.



How can you register to vote in New Jersey?
