Case Chats: Paper Presentations

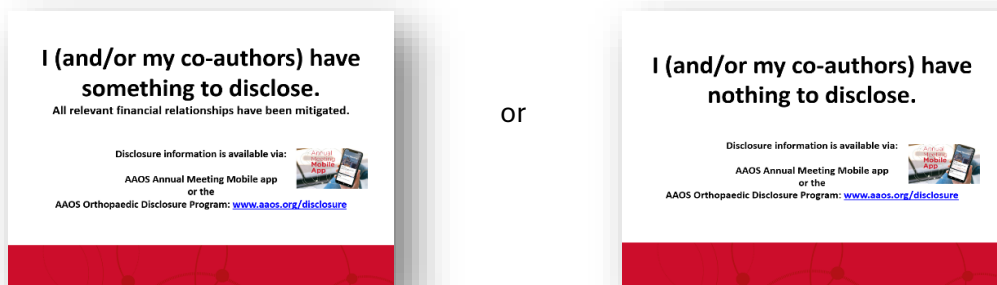
There are nine paper presentations in each one-hour session. Each presentation should be no longer than **four minutes** in length. All paper presenters are required to submit the following items by December 9:

- A full research manuscript
- A case study related to your research

Presentation

Your PowerPoint presentation can be uploaded prior to the meeting (via our AV partner's site, Orchestra), or you may upload your presentation on-site in the Speaker Ready Room. Presenting authors will be notified via email when the Orchestra site is open for uploads, generally a few weeks prior to the meeting.

Tips:

- Visit the Speaker Ready Room prior to your session to upload and/or review your presentation.
- Arrive in the presentation room at least 10 minutes prior to the start of the session.
- Sit in the front row reserved for presenters.
- Be prepared to participate in Q&A and discussion.
