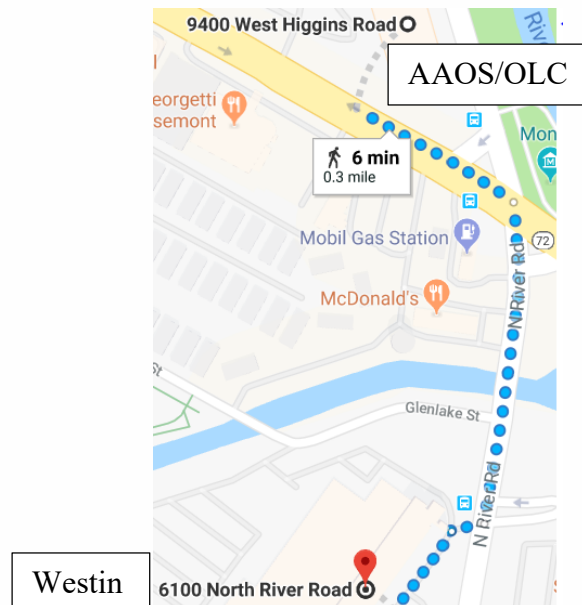
### **HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS**
