**COURSE LOCATION**

**GROUND TRANSPORTATION AND PARKING**

The Park City Hotel (Grand Summit) is 35 miles from the Salt Lake City International Airport. For those lodging at the Grand Summit, Silverado and Sundial parking is complimentary. For those not lodging that are driving in daily to attend meetings, parking is available at the Grand Summit for an \$8 per day charge.

Canyon Transportation is the recommended ground transportation service to and from the Salt Lake City International Airport. Reservations can be made on-line <http://canyontransport.com/> or by calling 801-255-1841. Please use group code **AAOS19** (not case sensitive). It will apply a 10% discount to whichever service selected. If you call in to make a reservation, be sure to let the reservation agent know you are with the American Academy of Orthopaedic Surgeons.

**HOTEL CHECK IN**

The Grand Summit hotel check in time is at 4pm. If guests arrive before 4pm, rooms may or may not be ready. If the room is ready, guests can check in prior to 4pm.
